Members of the Mountville Fire Company No. 1, Municipal Officials & Residents,

The Mountville Fire Company No. 1 proudly answered 386 requests for assistance in 2023. The department was on scene an average of 31 minutes per incident. The average personnel turnout per incident remained at only 6. Currently we have 29 responding firefighters from Mountville Fire Company, ten members answered 25% or more of the calls, four members answered 40% or more of the calls and the top responder answered 54%.

These statistics mirror 2022. We continue to maintain and provide emergency services to Mountville Borough, West Hempfield Township, and surrounding areas but, unfortunately staffing continues to be our biggest concern to our organization and to the residents of the municipalities we serve. Unfortunately, in recent years, we have not added any additional responders beyond replacing the ones that we have lost.

While I, as the chief, have no immediate solution beyond the work that we already have in progress (SAFER Grant), the fire company in collaboration with the municipalities must intensify our joint efforts in finding one. If Mountville Fire Company No. 1 were to lose any of our top 10 responders, this would significantly impact on our ability to respond to calls. Currently two of our top ten responders are high school students that will be moving onto higher education. This will considerably impact our response abilities.

The Mountville Fire Company No. 1 continues to work closely with West Hempfield Fire & Rescue as a short-term fix to our staffing shortcomings, but the hard reality is both departments are struggling to adequately staff units. Neighboring municipalities have already turned to a staffing model that includes paid staffing options to supplement the volunteers. Our hope is to avoid this and provide volunteer staffing for as long as possible. However, reflecting on our staffing numbers, it seems like this may not be possible.

In 2023, Mountville Fire Company No. 1 responded to five first due incidents (two Mountville Borough, three West Hempfield Township) where active fire endangered a total of \$1.8 million (pre-incident property value). Due to the extreme efforts of Mountville Fire Company #1 and mutual aid companies, the total loss was only \$238,250. This equates to 86% property saved (\$1,512,500).

Mountville Fire Company No. 1 continues to provide air supply support for working fires for the entire western part of Lancaster County and beyond. Those calls totaled 25 this year. In addition to emergency air support calls, Mountville Fire Company No. 1 refills other stations air filling systems. These were requested a total of 18 times.

Public education and fire safety is another service provided by Mountville Fire Company No. 1. A total of eight events connected our members with the community, including over 120 adults and over 160 children. Our safety professionals provided observations for two licensed care facilities in our first due area. Additionally, our members planned and executed community events such as the Mountville Days Carnival and Cookies with Santa where the fire company positively interacted with thousands of members within our community.

Our hours of service donated are as follows: 1,136 hours on incidents, 1,333 hours training, and 1,516 for all other activities needed to operate the fire company throughout the year. Combined, these equal 3,985 hours given to our community. As always, this official number is grossly under documented from the actual hours needed to operate. We hope that the municipalities and citizens we serve are aware and value the service of our volunteers.

As I close this year-end report marking my 20<sup>th</sup> year as Chief of Mountville Fire Company No. 1, I want to thank the members of our fire company, they make me so proud to be their chief. I also extend my sincere gratitude to Mountville Borough Council Members, West Hempfield Township Supervisors, and residents for their contributions in assisting the fire company's mission.

As we embark on 2024, we seek assistance from invested individuals and municipalities to actively join us in open dialogue and to provide a clear plan of action to complete the necessary steps to increase the number of active volunteers willing and able to serve our community. We seek this opportunity not only for the betterment of our community, but also for an effort to maintain lower operational costs and avoid the need for paid personnel.

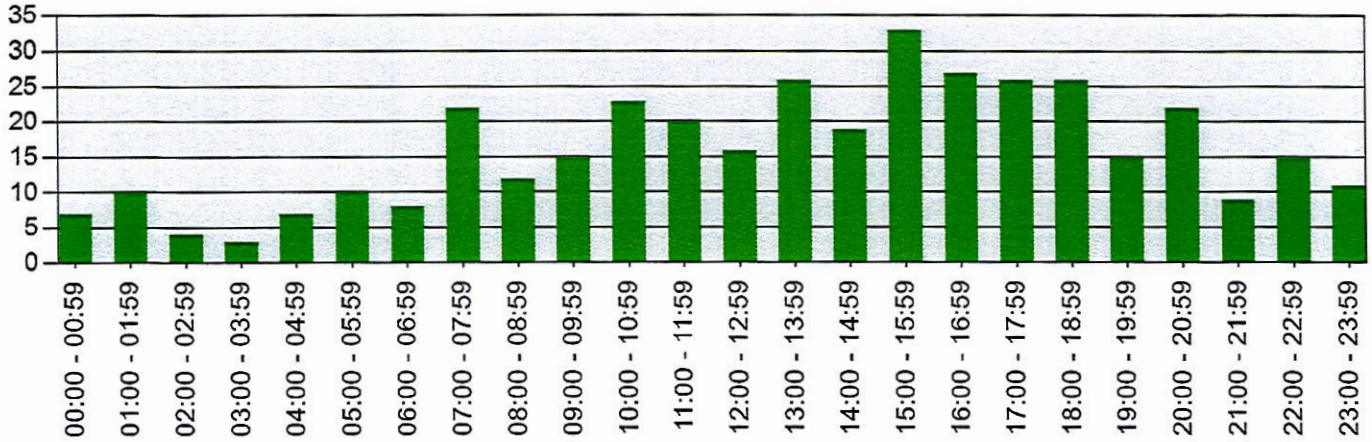

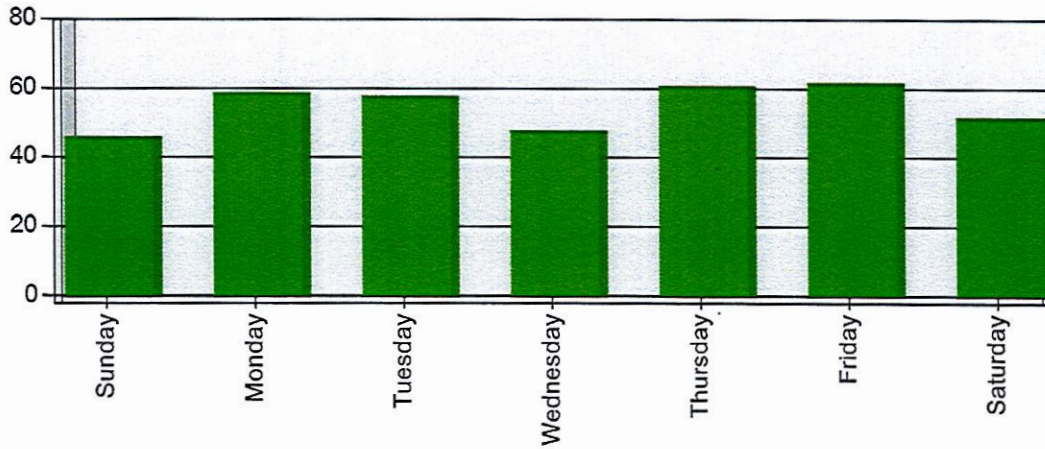
